

# ULTIMATE TEXAS HOLD'EM

Ultimate Texas Hold'em features head-to-head play against the dealer, and an optional bonus bet that pays odds if the player's final five card hand is a Three of a Kind or better.

To begin each round, players make equal bets in the Ante and Blind circles and may also make the Trips bonus bet. Once players receive their hole cards, they can either check or make a Play wager three to four times their ante. The dealer then reveals the three-card flop.

After the Flop has been dealt, each player who has not placed a Play wager may either check or place a Play wager in an amount two times the amount of the player's Ante wager. The dealer then will deal the last two community cards. Each player who has not placed a Play wager may either place a Play wager in an amount equal to the player's Ante wager or they may fold.

The dealer then reveals the turn and river cards and if the player hasn't already made a wager, they can fold or bet one times their Ante wager.

Next, the dealer reveals his two hole cards and announces his hand. If the player's hand beats the dealer, his Play and Ante bets win even money. If the dealer's hand beats the player, the player's wagers lose. If the player's hand ties the dealer's hand, their bets push. The Blind bet pays if the player's winning hand is at least a Straight, but if the player beats the dealer with less than a Straight, it pushes. The dealer needs at least a pair to qualify. If the dealer doesn't qualify, he returns each player's Ante and all other bets receive action.

## PROGRESSIVE JACKPOT

A player may choose to play the optional

Progressive Jackpot wager by placing \$1 on the bet. All progressive pays are based on five card poker hands. In order to qualify for one of the progressive jackpot payouts, players will need to use the player's two hole cards plus the first three community cards (also known as the flop).

The envy bonus shall be paid to any player who has a progressive wager on the current hand and another player at the table has been dealt a qualifying hand. Players may win more than one envy bet in the same round of play. Should a player be eligible for a winning progressive payout, the casino shall pay the following odds on all payouts:

HAND TYPE	PAYS	ENVY
ROYAL FLUSH	100%	\$1,000
STRAIGHT FLUSH	10%	\$300
FOUR-OF-A-KIND	\$300	N/A
FULL HOUSE	\$50	N/A
FLUSH	\$40	N/A
STRAIGHT	\$30	N/A
THREE-OF-A-KIND	\$9	N/A

The aggregate payout per player is \$50,000, not including the progressive jackpot
